Dear Commissioners:

Pursuant to Ordering Clause No. 2 in Public Service Commission Order, issued and effective September 20, 2013, in the above captioned proceeding, Central Hudson Gas & Electric Corporation ("Central Hudson" or "the Company") hereby files the following amended tariff leaf to its Schedule for Electric Service, PSC No. 15 – Electricity. The amendment is filed September 26, 2013 to become effective October 1, 2013.

Case 13-E-0232 orders the distribution of a NYSERDA administered refund to the Company's electric utility customers as a result of an approved settlement between Constellation Energy Commodities Group, Inc. and FERC Enforcement Staff. The aforementioned Order approved the Company's proposal to refund its share of the Constellation settlement on a volumetric basis to all retail delivery customers through the Company's Miscellaneous Charge component of its Energy Cost Adjustment Mechanism. As a result, the tariff changes contained herein reflect the addition of references to such Commission approved adjustments in the calculation of the Miscellaneous Charges Factor of the Energy Cost Adjustment Mechanism.

As directed by Ordering Clause No. 3 of the aforementioned Order, the requirements of Section 66(12)(b) of the Public Service Law as to newspaper publication for the amendment listed herein has been waived.
