The purpose of this filing is to revise the applicability provisions and make minor clarifying revisions to Rule No. 34.3-Empire Zone Rider (EZR), Rule No. 34.7 Excelsior Jobs Program (EJP), and Service Classification No. 4 – Untransformed Service to Certain Customers Taking Power From Projects of the New York Power Authority. The revisions included in this filing are:

- 1) Revisions to the applicability sections of EZR and EJP, specifically revising Rule 34.3.1.1.1 and Rule 34.7.1.1.1, to include Service Classification No. 4 customers to the list of customers who may qualify to receive EZR and EJP discounted service.
- 2) The addition of Rule 34.3.1.1.5 and Rule 34.7.1.1.5 to clarify that SC 4 customers who qualify for EZR and EJP discounted service may not combine delivery discounts on the same load. The combining of delivery discounts will be addressed in the collaborative initiated by the Public Service Commission in Case No. 13-E-0109 which will address the best method to implement the New York Power Authority's proposal to allow customers to combine their awarded Preservation Power, Replacement Power or Expansion Power low-cost supply allocation with their Empire Zone or Excelsior Jobs delivery discount. This collaborative will be initiated by the Commission at a future date.
- 3) Revisions have been made to Leaf Nos. 401 and 407 of SC No. 4 to make clarifying revisions regarding EZR and EJP supplemental service.

4) Minor clarifying revisions have also been made to Leaf Nos. 168, 171, 194.8, 194.9, and 194.10 to change “non-discounted” service to either non EJP or non EZR service and remove the notation \*\*All EJP Customers pay full standard tariff charges on their non-EJP load.

Attachment 1 included with this filing contains redlined leaves to show where the changes to the above leaves have occurred.

Because of the clarifying nature of this filing, waiver of the newspaper publication requirements of PSL §66-12 and 16NYCRR 720.8 is requested for this filing. Service Classification No. 4 customers will be notified of the above revisions when they apply for EZR or EJP.
