On June 13, 2013, the Commission issued an Order Raising Net Metering Limits in the above case number directing the major electric utilities to make tariff amendments to increase the minimum limitation for net metering under Public Service §66-j to 3% of 2005 peak load. These amendments were directed to be filed on not less than one day’s notice to become effective on July 1, 2013.

Ordering Clause No. 1 of this order waived the requirements of Public Service Law §66(12)(b) as to newspaper publication of these tariff amendments.
