The attached leaf, issued by Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation, d/b/a National Grid ("Company"), is being transmitted for filing in accordance with the requirements of the New York State Public Service Commission ("Commission"), State of New York:

Fifth Revised Leaf No. 404

To P.S.C. No. 220 Electricity

Effective: April 19, 2103

Purpose of Filing

On May 27, 2010, the Company filed tariff revisions of a housekeeping nature to Service Classification No. 4 – Untransformed Service to Certain Customers Taking Power from Projects of the New York Power Authority. The filing improved the organization and the completeness of the then current SC4. The revisions were of a "housekeeping" nature and had no impact on customers or rates. On August 16, 2010, the Commission approved these housekeeping revisions in Order issued in Case No. 10-E-0258

It has been brought to the Company's attention a sentence was erroneously omitted from the currently effective tariff. Specifically, the first sentence has been added to Item 7(a) on Leaf No. 404 to correct the omission in the previous filing and to reflect the previous and current billing methodology. No customer has been impacted by this omission.

Since this filing is of a housekeeping/conforming nature, it is respectfully requested that this filing become effective on thirty days notice. Also, it is requested that the requirements of newspaper publication as required by the Commission's regulations of 16 NYCRR Section 720-8 be waived for this filing.

Please advise the undersigned of any action taken regarding this filing.
