Dear Acting Secretary Cohen:

Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. ("Con Edison" or the "Company") is filing a revision to the Statement of Monthly Adjustment Clause ("MAC") to P.S.C. No. 10 – Electricity as follows:

MAC – Statement No. 14 to P.S.C. No. 10 – Electricity

This Statement is to become effective on March 1, 2013.

The statement is issued pursuant to General Rule 26.1 of the Company's tariff. It contains a per-kWh charge applicable to customers not billed under standby rates and a customer charge per month and per-kW charges applicable to customers billed under standby rates.

Pursuant to the Public Service Commission's <u>Order Denying Petition for Recovery of Charges</u>, issued and effective February 14, 2013, in Case 09-E-0428 (the "Order"), the MAC commencing with rates effective March 1, 2013 will no longer include an estimate of charges for firm transmission service under the PJM Interconnection L.L.C. Open Access Transmission Tariff. Additionally, the Order directed Con Edison to refund any such costs recovered to date. The Company will reflect such refunds in the next regularly scheduled monthly Adjustment Factor – MAC in accordance with the Order.
