Dear Acting Secretary Cohen:

On December 14, 2012, Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. (the "Company") made a tariff filing with the Public Service Commission (the "Commission"), proposing changes to its Schedule for Electricity, P.S.C. No. 10 – Electricity, proposing changes to the Company's tariffed Demand Response ("DR") programs: Rider S - Commercial System Relief Program, Rider U - Distribution Load Relief Program, and Rider L - Direct Load Control Program. The tariff changes were proposed to become effective March 18, 2013.

At the request of the Staff of the Department of Public Service, the Company has agreed to postpone to April 22, 2013, the effective date of the tariff changes that were filed on December 14, 2012. Accordingly, the Company hereby submits Supplement No. 11 to P.S.C. No. 10 – Electricity.

This Supplement is issued on 30 days' notice and has an effective date of March 28, 2013. However, since the tariff leaves currently have an effective date of March 18, 2013, the Company requests that it be authorized to put the Supplement filed today into effect on short notice, <u>i.e.</u>, March 18, 2013. The Company also respectfully requests waiver of notice requirements of the proposed change in the effective dates.
