In compliance with Ordering Clause No. 1 of the Commission's Order in Case 14-M-0196 ("Order"), issued and effective September 8, 2014, Central Hudson Gas & Electric Corporation ("Central Hudson" or "the Company"), hereby files the attached amended tariff leaves to become effective on October 1, 2014:

On May 22, 2014, Central Hudson Gas & Electric Corporation ("Central Hudson" or "the Company") filed a petition requesting approval to establish tariff fees for certain customers who choose to opt out of using Automated Meter Reading (AMR) devices. Included in that tariff filing was a proposal to require those that choose to opt out and maintain a non-AMR meter to pay a non-AMR service fee to cover additional costs to the Company to manually read and maintain the non-AMR meters. The tariff revisions filed herein update the non-AMR service fee pursuant to the aforementioned Order.

The Company is arranging to comply with the requirements of 66(12)(b) of the Public Service Law by publishing notices of the changes proposed herein in the October 8<sup>th</sup>, 15<sup>th</sup>, 22<sup>nd</sup>, and 29<sup>th</sup> issues of the Catskill Daily Mail, the Daily Freeman, the Times Herald Record and the Poughkeepsie Journal. The Putnam County Courier will publish notices of the changes on October 9<sup>th</sup>, 16<sup>th</sup>, 23<sup>rd</sup>, and 30<sup>th</sup>.
