RDM Statement No. 4 to PSC 120 Electric

The filing of service classification or sub-classification specific RDM surcharge/credit rates is in accordance with the Companies' filed tariffs and Appendix U of the Rate Plan¹. NYSEG and RG&E will file the annual service classification or sub-classification specific RDM surcharge/credit rates with the Commission, on not less than 30 days notice, to be effective November 1st of each year.
