Dear Secretary Burgess:

On April 3, 2014, Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. (the "Company") made a tariff filing with the Public Service Commission (the "Commission"), proposing changes to the Company's Schedule for Electricity Service, P.S.C. No. 10 – Electricity, related to Rider L - Direct Load Control Program. The tariff changes were proposed to become effective on July 1, 2014.

At the request of the Staff of the Department of Public Service, the Company has agreed to postpone to August 1, 2014, the effective date of the tariff changes that were filed on April 3, 2014. Accordingly, the Company hereby submits Supplement No. 16 to P.S.C. No. 10 – Electricity.

This Supplement is issued on 30 days' notice and has an effective date of July 26, 2014. However, since the tariff leaves currently have an effective date of July 1, 2014, the Company requests that it be authorized to put the Supplement filed today into effect on short notice, i.e., July 1, 2014. The Company also respectfully requests waiver of notice requirements of the proposed change in the effective dates.
