The following schedule, issued by Verizon New York Inc. ("Verizon"), is transmitted for filing in accordance with the requirements of the Public Service Commission, State of New York, to be effective July 1, 2014:

This filing is made pursuant to the Federal Communications Commission's Report and Order reforming the intercarrier compensation and universal service systems, 26 FCC Rcd 17663 ("FCC Order"), and subsequent orders, and implements the third step in the transition of switched access rate reductions.

The filing reduces terminating switched access rates to one-third of the difference between the current rates and \$0.0007. A new Composite Terminating End Office Charge has been introduced to apply to terminating end office switching minutes. The Local Switching and Shared End Office minute of use rates have been zero-rated for terminating usage and replaced by the Composite Terminating End Office Charge. This approach has been introduced in the interstate and intrastate access tariffs.

Verizon issued an Industry Notice on April 30, 2014 informing the telecommunications industry of these changes. Therefore, Verizon respectfully requests that the requirements of newspaper publication be waived.
