With this filing AT&T is making revisions to the VoIP language with regards to rating of VoIP –PSTN traffic, and the calculation and application of Percent-VoIP Usage factors. The reason for this change is that a terminating VoIP factor is no longer needed in billing since all terminating traffic has been at or below parity since July 2013.
