**ORDER MODIFYING COMMUNITY DISTRIBUTED GENERATION MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS**

The enclosed leaves, issued by Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation d/b/a National Grid, are being transmitted for filing in compliance with the order issued in Case 15-E-0082 (the “Order”) on March 13, 2017 by the New York State Public Service Commission (“Commission”).

To PSC No. 220 Electricity

Effective: April 1, 2017

The Order directed the listed utilities to file tariff revisions necessary to remove the ten member minimum requirement for Community Distributed Generation projects that are located on the site of a property serving multiple residential or non-residential customers, as discussed in the Order, on not less than 10 days’ notice to become effective April 1, 2017.

In compliance with the Order, Rule 29.2.3.1 has been added to Rule 29 – Community Distributed Generation to include the above revision.

Attachment 1 included with this filing indicates where the changes have occurred.

Ordering Clause 2 of the Order waived the requirements of Public Service Law §66(12)(b) as to newspaper publication of these tariff amendments.
