## Re: Case 15-E-0745 – Further Compliance Filing to Effectuate Amendments of Public Service Law 70-a Transfer of Street Light Systems

Dear Secretary Burgess:

In compliance with the Commission's Order Addressing Petition and Directing Tariff Revisions in Case 15-E-0745 issued and effective February 23, 2017, Central Hudson Gas & Electric Corporation ("Central Hudson" or "the Company") hereby files the following proposed tariff amendments to become effective on March 1, 2017.

## P.S.C. No. 15 – Electricity

Pursuant to Order Approving Tariff Amendments with Modifications in Case 15-E-0745 Issued and Effective October 14, 2016, the Company filed amendments which provided for the establishment of a process to facilitate the transfer of complete systems of street light equipment, including supporting infrastructure pursuant to Section 70-a of the Public Service Law effectuated through Chapter 495 of the Laws of 2015.

Subsequent to the Company's compliance filing, the Mid-Hudson Streetlight Consortium ("MHSC") filed a petition for clarification of the October 14, 2016 Order. The Petition requested clarification regarding the Company's pre-attachment survey fee. By its Order dated February 23, 2017, the Commission clarifies that Central Hudson is not required to remove this pre-attachment survey fee because the charge is not associated with the sale of street lighting facilities. However, pursuant to Ordering Paragraph 1, the filing herein provides clarification to the tariff to specify that the pre-attachment survey fee will only be required for new attachments on Company-owned utility poles.

Pursuant to Ordering Paragraph 3, the requirements of Public Service Law §66(12)(b) and 16 NYCRR §720-8.1 as to newspaper publication with respect to the tariff filings listed in the Appendix and the amendments directed in Clauses 1 are waived.
