The above Order directed utilities to make the following two revisions: 1) eliminate the net metered limitation on remote net metered satellite accounts and, 2) add clarifying language regarding the 2 MW limitation for multiple remote net metered hosts serving one remote net metered satellite account. These revisions were submitted to the Commission on November 20, 2015.

The Order also directed the Company to include language in the filed tariff leaves grandfathering against the tariff changes discussed above for projects in-service or under development resulting in more than 2 MW serving a Satellite Account, if certain criteria were met by December 1, 2015. The Company inadvertently did not include these grandfathering provisions in the tariff filed on November 20, 2015 and is respectfully submitting these revisions at this time.

Attachment 1 to this filing indicates where the changes have occurred.

Ordering Clause 2 of this order waived the requirements of Public Service Law §66(12)(b) as to newspaper publication of these tariff amendments.
