Purpose of Filing

The purpose of this filing is to update the System Benefits Charge ("SBC") Statement issued to the Commission in the above case numbers. Pursuant to the Company's orders in the above cases, the Company is directed to perform a reconciliation of previous years' collections for the Clean Energy Fund and Energy Efficiency Surcharge in December of each year to be effective with the first billing batch of the Company's January billing cycle. In accordance with Rule 41.5 of PSC No. 220 the Statement of SBC will be filed on no less than 15 days' notice to become effective January 1st of each year.

The purpose of this filing is to incorporate in the current collection factor the current SBC CEF and EES assessment amounts and a reconciliation of recoveries for calendar year 2016 (eleven months actual, one month forecast). Attachment 1 sets forth the derivation of the factors which will become effective January 1, 2017-December 31, 2017.
