The purpose of this filing was to incorporate in the current collection factor the current SBC CEF and EES assessment amounts and a reconciliation of recoveries for calendar year 2016 (eleven months actual, one month forecast). Attachment 1 sets forth the derivation of the factors which will become effective January 1, 2017-December 31, 2017.
