Orange and Rockland Utilities, Inc. (the "Company") hereby submits for filing  
Statement RDM-9 to its Schedule for Gas Service, P.S.C. No. 4 – GAS ("Gas Tariff").  
This statement is issued November 21, 2016, to become effective December 1, 2016.

The purpose of this filing is to implement the reconciliation of the Company's gas  
revenue decoupling mechanism for the period November 1, 2015 through October 31,  
2016 ("Rate Year 1") in accordance with General Information Section No. 25, Revenue  
Decoupling Mechanism ("RDM") Adjustment, of the Gas Tariff.

The Rate Year 1 cumulative net delivery revenue shortfall for Group A and Group  
B<sup>1</sup> is \$811,450 and \$879,450, respectively, including interest.

Group-specific RDM adjustments have been determined to refund this excess  
net delivery revenue over the twelve-month period commencing December 1, 2016.
