RE: CASE 14-M-0094 – Order Authorizing the Clean Energy Fund Framework

Dear Secretary Burgess:

In accordance with the New York Public Service Commission's Order Authorizing the Clean Energy Fund Framework ("Order") issued January 21, 2016 in the above-referenced case, The Brooklyn Union Gas Company d/b/a National Grid NY (the "Company") hereby submits the following tariff leaves and statement to become effective on March 1, 2016:

Fifth Revised Leaf No. 138.50.1 Statement of System Benefits Charge No. 15 To Schedule for Gas Service, PSC No. 12-GAS.

After discussions with Staff, it was determined that further revisions were necessary. The purpose of this filing is to further amend the Company's tariff provisions to implement a surcharge to collect for The Clean Energy Fund ("CEF") in accordance with directing paragraph 7 consistent with the Order. The Company proposes to implement the CEF to customers taking service under Service Classification Nos. 1A, 1AR, 1B, 1BR, 1BI, 1B-DG, 2-1, 2-2, 3, 4A, 4B, 7, 17-CTS 1A, 17-CTS 1AR, 17-CTS 1B, 17-CTS 1BR, 17-CTS 1BI, 17-CTS 1BI, 17-CTS 2-1, 17-CTS 2-2, 17-CTS 3, 17-CTS 4A, 17-CTS 4B, and 17-CTS 7. Attachment 1 contains the calculations used to develop the CEF rate. The CEF will be set forth on the Statement of System Benefits Charge and will be included in the calculation of the total System Benefits Charge included on the customer's bill.
