Re: Salamanca Board of Public Utilities – Submittal of Tariff Leaves for Service Classification 1 and 2, Purchase of Renewable Energy from New Distributed Generation

Dear Secretary Burgess:

Enclosed herewith are the following materials, identified below, issued and transmitted for filing on behalf of the Salamanca Board of Public Utilities ("BPU") in accordance with the requirements of the Public Service Commission.

The Salamanca BPU is proposing an amendment its Service Classification Nos. 1 and 2, respectively residential and non-residential customers, to include net metering services for solar and wind generation. The proposed net metering provisions are similar to net metering tariffs of other New York municipalities such as Massena, Freeport and Jamestown. The BPU's net metering for eligible customers will apply to solar or wind electric generating equipment of no more than 15kW capacity. The aggregate maximum purchase by the BPU of solar or wind generation will be 200kW, or one percent of the BPU's average system load.

The BPU is enclosing herein Draft New Tariff Leaves for PSC No. 1, Electricity, containing the provisions for the purchase of electricity from new, renewable distributed generation as contained in the following:

Leaf No. 15, Revision 0 Leaf No. 16, Revision 0

These revisions are issued as of December 23, 2015 and are proposed to become effective April 1, 2016.

Newspaper publication regarding this filing will be made in accordance with the Commission's regulations in the local newspaper for four successive weeks. The revised P.S.C. Schedule No. 1 is being made available to the public by contacting the Office of the Secretary to the Board, Salamanca Board of Public Utilities, 225 Wildwood Avenue, Salamanca, New York.
