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The proposed revision discontinues the resale of Lifeline and Connection Charge Assistance Plan services pursuant to the FCC's rulings in Lifeline and Link Up Reform and Modernization, et al., WC Docket No. 11-42 et al., Second Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking, Order on Reconsideration, Second Report and Order and Memorandum Opinion and Order, FCC 15-71, released June 22, 2015. Accordingly, Verizon will cease providing resold Lifeline and Connection Charge Assistance Plan services effective February 9, 2016. In addition, Verizon will eliminate the Lifeline discount on all existing resold Lifeline services effective February 9, 2016
