RE: Case 15-E-0050 and 13-E-0030, Extension of Con Edison Electric Rate Case

Dear Secretary Burgess:

Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. ("Con Edison" or the "Company") is filing with the Public Service Commission (the "Commission") amendments to its Schedule for Electricity Service, P.S.C. No. 10 – Electricity (the "Electric Tariff"), applicable to its customers in the City of New York and the County of Westchester. The Company is also filing amendments to its Schedule for New York Power Authority ("NYPA" or "PASNY") Delivery Service – P.S.C. No. 12 (the "PASNY Tariff), applicable to delivery by the Company of power and associated energy to Authority Public Customers under the PASNY Tariff.

The Company's Electric Tariff Leaves and PASNY Tariff Leaves are issued to become effective on January 1, 2016. The specific Tariff Leaves and Statements being revised are identified in Appendix A.

Reason for Filing

The Commission's <u>Order Adopting Terms of Joint Proposal to Extend Electric Rate Plan</u>, issued and effective June 19, 2015, in Cases 15-E-0050 and 13-E-0030 (the "Order") adopted the Joint Proposal ("JP") set forth in Appendix A of the Order. Pursuant to pages 26 through 27 of the JP, the Company is required to file various changes to its Electric and PASNY Tariffs and Statements.

Changes

Pursuant to the Order, the Company is filing Tariff changes, as described below:

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¹ The PASNY Tariff is titled, "Delivery Service Rate Schedule Implementing and Part of the Service Agreement Between the Power Authority of the State of New York (PASNY) and the Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. (the Company) dated March 10, 1989."

- The Temporary Rate Adjustment sections in the Electric Tariff (General Rule 26.8 on Leaf 359) and PASNY Tariff (Leaf 10) have been changed to extend the effectiveness of the Temporary Credit and modify the temporary credit amounts.
- The RDM sections of the Electric Tariff (General Rule 26.2(3) on Leaf 351) and PASNY Tariff (Leaf 22) have been modified to change the effective dates of RDM targets.
- General Rule 15.2 of the Electric Tariff (Leaf 119) has been modified to extend the effectiveness of the reconnection charge waiver applicable to low-income customers and specify that reconnection fee waivers will be capped at \$500,000 for Rate Year 3 unless revised by Commission Order in Case 14-M-0565.

As further required by the Order, the Company is filing revised Statements of Temporary Rate Adjustment applicable to the Electric Tariff and the PASNY Tariff to extend the effectiveness of the temporary credit through December 31, 2016.

In addition, pursuant to page 19 of the JP, an additional \$3.45 million in annual purchased power working capital costs above the level in RY2 rates will be recovered through the merchant function charge commencing January 1, 2016. This will be reflected in the Statement of Merchant Function Charge ("MFC") effective on January 1, 2016, to be filed no less than three days prior to the effective date pursuant to General Rule 25.3 of the Electric Tariff.

Conclusion and Notice

Pursuant to Ordering Clause 4 of the Order, this filing is being made to go into effect on a temporary basis on January 1, 2016.

The Company will publish notice of the proposed tariff changes on December 8, 15, 22, and 29, 2015. Copies of this filing are being sent electronically to the active party list in Cases 15-E-0050 and 13-E-0030.
