**Re: Case 15-G-0601, Rider H – Distributed Generation Rate
for Non Residential Customers**

Dear Secretary Burgess:

On October 16, 2015, Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. (the “Company”) made tariff filings with the Public Service Commission proposing changes to the Company’s Schedule for Gas Service, P.S.C. No. 9 – Gas. The tariff changes, which would allow customers with separately metered distributed generation facilities, at the same location and under the same customer name, to aggregate the generating capacity of those distributed generation facilities for the purpose of qualifying for billing under Rate II of Rider H were proposed to become effective on February 1, 2016.

Based on a request from the Staff of the Department of Public Service, the Company is filing to postpone to April 1, 2016, the effective date of the tariff changes that were filed on October 16, 2015. Accordingly, the Company hereby submits Supplement No. 69 to P.S.C. No. 9 – Gas. The Supplement postpones the effective date of the tariff changes to April 1, 2016.

The Supplement is issued on 30 days’ notice and has an effective date of January 21, 2016. The Company respectfully requests waiver of notice requirements of the proposed change in the effective date.
