RE: Case 15-E-0407 – Order Establishing Interim Ceilings on the Interconnection of Net Metered Generation

Dear Secretary Burgess:

The enclosed leaf, issued by Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation d/b/a National Grid (the “Company”), is being transmitted for filing in compliance with the order issued in Case 15-E-0407 (the “Order”) on October 16, 2015 by the New York State Public Service Commission (“Commission”).

Fourth Revised Leaf No. 200

To PSC No. 220 Electricity

Effective: November 6, 2015

The above Order directed all electric utilities to file tariff leaves, by October 30, 2015, implementing revisions to the ceilings on the interconnection of net metered generation in conformance with the requirements set forth in the Order. On October 28, 2015 the Company submitted the required filing with revisions to Rule No. 36- Net Metering for Solar Electric Generating Equipment, Farm Waste Electric Generating Equipment, Micro-Combined Heat and Power Generating Equipment, Fuel Cell Electric Generating Equipment, and Micro-Hydroelectric Generating Equipment and Rule No. 37 - Net Metering For Residential, Farm Service and Non-Residential Wind Electric Generating Systems as Defined in Public Service Law (“PSL”) 66-1. It has come to the Company’s attention that this revision did not apply to Rule 37 and therefore is removing the revised language to the above leaf.

Waiver of short notice is requested for this leaf to become effective on less than 30 day’s notice on November 6, 2015.

Also, as directed in Ordering Clause 3 of the Order, the requirement for newspaper publication is waived for this filing.
