The attached leaves, issued by Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation, d/b/a National Grid ("Company"), are being transmitted for filing in accordance with the requirements of the Public Service Commission ("Commission"), State of New York.

The purpose of this filing is to propose housekeeping/clarifying revisions to Rule 34 - Economic Development Programs, Program 5-Recharge New York ("RNY") Power Program and Service Classification No. 12 – Rule 6.2.4 with the following revisions.

- 1. Leaf No. 194.2, Rule 34.6.2.5 This Rule has been revised to more accurately describe how notification from the New York Power Authority ("NYPA") is received by the Company when an account received RNY service. The language change is more consistent with the other utilities tariffs in regards to the notification for changes and notifications from NYPA.
- 2. Leaf No. 194.2, Rule 34.6.3.1 This Rule has been revised to eliminate the language that states the Company will revert the Customer back to the billing period of the appropriate service classification from calendar month billing when the Customer loses their RNY allocation. The Company believes that this is an unnecessary administrative burden on the Company and may become confusing to the customer who is already established on calendar month billing.
- 3. Leaf No. 194.2, Rule 34.6.3.2 has been eliminated in its entirety. This Rule refers to contractual supply obligations between NYPA and its customers, which has no impact on the Company or its obligations to the customer. Therefore, the Company believes it should be removed from the tariff to avoid customer confusion.
- 4. Leaf Nos. 466 and 467 The tariff leaves have been revised to update the filing procedures for Standardized and Individually Negotiated Contracts.

Because of the housekeeping/clarifying nature of this filing, waiver of the newspaper publication requirements of PSL § 66-12 and 16 NYCRR Part 720.8 is requested for this filing. Also, Attachment 1 included with this filing contains a redlined leaf showing where the revisions are proposed.
