In compliance with Ordering Paragraph 3 in the Public Service Commission's order issued and effective October 16, 2015 ("Order") in the above captioned proceeding, Central Hudson Gas & Electric Corporation ("Central Hudson" or "the Company") hereby files amended tariff leaves to its Schedule for Electric Service, PSC No. 15 - Electricity.

The Commission's Order Granting Reconsideration in Part (the "Order"), issued and effective October 16, 2015, in Case 15-E-0822, directed the utilities to file tariff changes to redirect CDG Host self-certifications to the interconnecting utility. In addition, amendments have been made to change the credit allocation methodology to allow Satellite Accounts to accumulate excess credits that do not expire at the end of an annual period. Pursuant to the Order, these revisions are filed October 23, 2015 to become effective on not less than one day's notice, on October 26, 2015.

Pursuant to Paragraph 4 of the Order, the requirements of Section 66(12)(b) of the Public Service Law regarding newspaper publication for the amendments listed herein are waived.
