Water Supply Enhancement Surcharge Statement No. 1

Effective: December 1, 2015

William K. Green (the Company) is requesting to increase its total annual revenues by approximately \$4,458 or 66%. This increase is necessary in order to cover increased operating expenses that cannot be recovered via the current rates that have been in effect since July 9, 1993. The Company is also requesting approval to change its tariff rates from a monthly rate to a quarterly rate billed in arrears.

The Company is also proposing to modify the restoration of service charges to be consistent with charges in the standard small water company tariff. The charge to restore service after discontinuance at the customer's request, for non-payment, or for violation of rules, is proposed to increase from \$5.00 to \$50 during normal business hours (8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday through Friday), from \$10.00 to \$75 outside of normal business hours Monday through Friday, and from \$10.00 to \$100 on weekends or public holidays.

In addition, the Company also requests approval to recover \$16,259 in extraordinary expenses it incurred in 2014 to rehabilitate its well supplies, install a new treatment system, and construct a new treatment building, as required by the Orange County Department of Health. The Company proposes to recover this amount through a surcharge to be collected quarterly over a five-year period.

The Company is also requesting waiver of the requirement of newspaper publication of the attached minor rate filing and will individually notify its customers of the proposed rate change and surcharge.

Other information will be provided as requested.
