Re: Case 14-E-0570 and Case 14-G-0571, AMR/AMI Meter Opt-Out

Dear Secretary Burgess:

On December 31, 2014, Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. (the “Company”) made tariff filings with the Public Service Commission proposing changes to the Company’s Schedule for Electricity Service, P.S.C. No. 10 – Electricity, and its Schedule for Gas Service, P.S.C. No. 9 – Gas. The tariff changes, which would allow residential customers to opt out of AMR/AMI metering, were proposed to become effective on April 1, 2015. The Company filed further tariff changes on May 19, 2015. The electric and gas filings made on December 31, 2014 and May 19, 2015, are currently postponed to November 1, 2015.

Following discussions with the Staff of the Department of Public Service, the Company is filing to postpone to January 1, 2016, the effective date of the tariff changes that were filed on December 31, 2014 and May 19, 2015. Accordingly, the Company hereby submits Supplement No. 31 to P.S.C. No. 10 – Electricity and Supplement No. 68 to P.S.C. No. 9 – Gas. The Supplements postpone the effective date of the tariff changes to January 1, 2016.

The Supplements are issued on 30 days’ notice and have an effective date of October 21, 2015. The Company respectfully requests waiver of notice requirements of the proposed change in the effective date.
