The supplement set forth below is filed by Central Hudson Gas & Electric Corporation (“Central Hudson” or “the Company”) on August 12, 2015 to become effective on September 11, 2015. The Company requests for this supplement to become effective on less than statutory notice on August 20, 2015.

The purpose of this filing is to respond to Staff’s request for additional time to allow Staff the opportunity to further review the filing presently before the Commission under this case number. On June 29, 2015, Central Hudson submitted a tariff filing to replace monetary crediting with volumetric crediting at remote net metered sites where non-demand rates are in effect for those prospective customers not grandfathered into monetary crediting under the Transition plan approved in the Public Service Commission’s order issued and effective April 17, 2015. It is proposed by this filing that the current effective date of August 20, 2015 be postponed to September 21, 2015.

The Company also requests a waiver of newspaper publication requirements of Public Service Law §66(12)(b) for this filing.
