Based on discussions with Department of Public Service Staff, these postponement supplements are being filed to permit additional review of the filing. These supplements propose to postpone the effective date of the filed tariff leaves until September 21, 2015. The Companies request that these supplements become effective on short notice and will take effect on August 20, 2015.

The Companies request that the requirement of Section 66(12)(b) of the Public Service Law and 16 NYCRR Section 720-8.1 as to newspaper publication be waived as these revisions do not affect any internal procedures or processes, and will not directly impact the Companies' customers.
