The attached statement, issued by Niagara Mohawk, d/b/a/ National Grid ("Company"), is being transmitted for filing in accordance with the requirements of the New York State Public Service Commission ("Commission"):

Statement of Supply Service Charges No. 43

To P.S.C. No. 214 Electricity

Effective: June 30, 2015

The above statement is being filed in accordance with Rule No. 46.4-Supply Service Charges in PSC No. 220 Electricity. Attachment 1 of this filing displays the derivation of these charges.

In accordance with Rule 46.3.4 of the tariff, the Company implemented the Supply Reconciliation Balance ("SRB") mechanism for Mass Market customers (SC-1 and SC-2ND) in the ESRM rates filed in May. By delaying a portion of the ESRM reconciliation, the Company was able to mitigate large month to month variances for Mass Market customers caused by reconciliations from prior months. A portion of the balance was credited back to customers in June ESRM rates and the remaining balance in the SRB is being credited back to customers in the July ESRM rates.

This Supply Service Charge Statement is to be filed with the Commission on not less than three (3) business days notice before the effective date. Supply Service Statement No.43 is effective June 30, 2015 for batch billed customers, and July 1, 2015 for calendar month billed customers.
