Effective: July 20, 2015

The above Order directed utilities to make the following two revisions: 1) revise the methodology of issuing excess credits to accounts that are satellite accounts of a non-residential non-demand host customer generator; and; 2) waive this new crediting methodology for certain grandfathered projects. This change in methodology and transition plan for certain grandfathered projects applies to customer-generators who qualify for remote net metering under PSL 66-j and 66-l. This filing complies with this directive and proposes revisions to Rule 36- Net Metering for Solar Electric Generating Equipment, Farm Waste Electric Generating Equipment, Micro-Combined Heat and Power Generating Equipment, and Fuel Cell Electric Generating Equipment and Rule 37- Net Metering For Residential, Farm Service and Non-Residential Wind Electric Generating Systems as Defined in Public Service Law (“PSL”) 66-1 .

Ordering Clause 2 of the Order directed utilities to file tariff changes by June 29, 2015 to become effective July 20, 2015.

Ordering Clause 3 of this order waived the requirements of Public Service Law §66(12)(b) as to newspaper publication of these tariff amendments.
