Dear Secretary Burgess:

By letter dated August 1, 2016, Orange and Rockland Utilities, Inc. (the “Company”) filed with the Public Service Commission (the “Commission”) amendments to its Schedule for Electric Service, P.S.C. No. 3 – Electricity, to become effective December 1, 2016.

The filing was made in compliance with the Commission’s Order Adopting a Ratemaking and Utility Revenue Model Policy Framework (the “REV Track 2 Order”), issued and effective May 19, 2016, in Case 14-M-0101, now Case 16-M-0430. Commission Staff has requested a postponement of the effective date of the proposed tariff amendments to January 1, 2017, in order to allow time for further review of the proposed changes. The Company accordingly files Supplement No. 20 to postpone the effective date of the tariff amendments included in its August 1, 2016 filing. Supplement No. 20 is issued November 1, 2016 with an effective date of December 1, 2016.

Pursuant to Ordering Clause 9 of the REV Track 2 Order, the Commission waived the requirement for newspaper publication of these changes. The Company therefore requests waiver of newspaper publication of the proposed changes since this filing is only postponing the effective date of the tariff changes already filed.
