Re: Case 16-E-0196, Standby Service Multi-Party Offset

Dear Secretary Burgess:

On April 4, 2016, Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. (the “Company”) made a tariff filing with the Public Service Commission proposing changes to the Company’s Schedule for Electricity Service, P.S.C. No. 10 – Electricity and the Schedule for New York Power Authority (“NYPA” or “PASNY”) Delivery Service, P.S.C. No. 12 – Electricity, to expand its Standby Service tariff provisions to allow a customer to use its generator to supply its own account(s) as well as the account(s) of one or more other customers located in the same building. The tariff changes were proposed to become effective on July 21, 2016.

At the request of the Staff of the Department of Public Service (“Staff”), the Company postponed to September 21, 2016, the effective date of the tariff changes that were filed on April 4, 2016. At Staff’s request, the Company is further postponing the effective date of the tariff changes to January 27, 2017. Accordingly, the Company hereby submits Supplement No. 37 to P.S.C. No. 10 – Electricity and Supplement No. 19 to P.S.C. No. 12 – Electricity to postpone the effective date of the tariff changes to January 27, 2017.

The Supplements are issued on 30 days’ notice and have an effective date of September 7, 2016. The Company also respectfully requests waiver of notice requirements of the proposed change in the effective date.
