Dear Secretary Burgess:

In accordance with Section 720-2 *et al.* of the Commission's regulations, 16 NYCRR § 720-2 *et al.*, KeySpan Gas East Corporation d/b/a National Grid ("the Company") hereby submits the tariff leaves listed on Attachment 1 to become effective December 1, 2016.

The purpose of this filing is to amend the Company's tariff, PSC No. 1- Gas, to change the temperature index for temperature controlled customers from the National Weather Service at Central Park to the National Weather Service at Farmingdale Airport. The amendments also revise the tariff to provide that interruptible customers may remain on gas in the following circumstances: 1) peaking supplies are dispatched ratably across a weekend and/or holiday with varying temperatures above and below 15° F; and 2) peaking supplies are dispatched based on a day ahead call option and actual temperatures are higher than forecast. In all cases, LNG and non-ratable peaking supplies will be minimized to preserve winter deliverability.

In accordance with Section 720-2.3 of the Commission's regulations, a proposed notice of this filing suitable for use under the State Administrative Procedure Act is also enclosed.
