The amended tariff leaf set forth below is filed by Central Hudson Gas & Electric Corporation ("Central Hudson" or "the Company") on May 12, 2016 to become effective on not less than 15 days' notice on June 1, 2016 in compliance with the Commission **Order Directing Modifications to Remote Net Metering Tariff** ("Order") in Case 15-E-0757 issued and effective April 20, 2016.

The purpose of this filing is to establish clarification in General Information Section 37 – Remote Net Metering of the Company's Schedule for Electric Service, PSC No. 15 - Electricity, regarding customer remote net metering eligibility requirements. The modifications include explicitly defining property ownership and the criteria for determining such ownership for customers with and without farm operations, who wish to remote net meter.

As directed in Ordering Clause No. 3 of the Commission's April 20, 2016 Order in this Case, the requirements of 66(12)(b) of the Public Service Law as to newspaper publication have been waived.
