## *Re: Pennsylvania Electric Company Waverly District Non-Utility Generation Cost Adjustment Clause Recovery, Case 11-E-0594*

Dear Secretary Phillips,

This filing is made in compliance with the Order of the New York Public Service Commission entered on October 8, 2021, at Case 11-E-0594 ("Order") that directed the Pennsylvania Electric Company ("Penelec") to file tariff revisions related to the removal of the non-utility generation ("NUG") Rider, to become effective on not less than 30 days' notice, within 30 days of the date verification was provided to the Secretary. Additionally, the Order waived the requirements of Public Service Law §66 (12) (b) and Title 16 of the New York Codes, Rules and Regulations §720-8.1 as to the newspaper publication. The tariff revisions remove the NUG Rider, Rider C, and all associated NUG Rider rate tariff language from the Company's tariff effective December 1, 2023.
