In accordance with General Information, Section 29 of P.S.C. No. 15 - Electricity, the Statement of Miscellaneous Charge listed below, and in accordance with General Information, Section 42 of P.S.C No 12 – Gas, the Statement of Miscellaneous Charge listed below are filed to become effective August 1, 2023 to set Phase 1 of the Arrears Reduction Program surcharge to zero.

The purpose of The Arrears Reduction Program Surcharge Phase 1 is designed to recover the costs and associated carrying charges related to Phase 1 of the Arrears Reduction Program pursuant to the June 16, 2022, order in Case 20-M-0266. Pursuant to the Company's tariff the Phase 1 surcharge was to be recovered over a one-year period ending July 31, 2023. Remaining program costs associated with Phase 1 will be reconciled through the Phase 2 surcharge during the next annual recovery period. Pursuant to the Company's tariff the Miscellaneous statements are filed 15 days prior to the effective date of August 1, 2023.
