This filing is made in compliance with the Order of the New York Public Service Commission entered on October 8, 2021, at Case 11-E-0594 that authorized Pennsylvania Electric Company ("Penelec") to set the non-utility generation ("NUG") Rider rate to zero, on one day's notice, to allow the remaining over-collection balance to be refunded to customers. Penelec requests that the NUG Rider rate be set to zero as of September 25, 2023. With NUG Rider billings through mid-October 2023, the Company expects the remaining overcollection to be fully refunded to customers. The Company will file a verification within 30 days of the termination of the NUG rider rate.
