The purpose of this filing is to modify existing Community Choice Aggregation ("CCA") tariff provisions to be consistent with the directives in the Commission's January 19, 2023 order in the captioned proceeding. Such changes include:

- 2. Clarification of additional data fields that will be available in the aggregated data set
- 3. Clarification to language describing newly eligible CCA customers
- 4. Reference to the dispute resolution process for CCA's
