Dear Secretary Phillips:

New York State Electric & Gas Corporation (“NYSEG”) and Rochester Gas and Electric Corporation (“RG&E”), (together the “Companies”) hereby file the following tariff leaves in compliance with Ordering Clause No. 4 of the Public Service Commission’s Order Modifying Clean Energy Standard Tier 1 Obligations in the above referenced proceedings, issued and effective April 20, 2023 (the “Order”) and Appendix 7-H (electronic tariff filing system) to the Commission's Codes, Rules and Regulations (16 NYCRR Appendix 7-H). The tariff leaves are to become effective on a temporary basis on June 1, 2023.

Purpose of Filing

The Companies are filing amendments to their respective tariffs in compliance with Ordering Clause No. 4 of the Order.

Currently, the costs of the Environmental Component of the Value Stack (NYSEG P.S.C. No. 120 – Rule 40.B, and RG&E P.S.C. No. 19 – Rule 26.B) are recovered through two separate recovery mechanisms. The Environmental Value [Out of Market Value] is recovered through the Transition Charge, and the Market Value of the Environmental component is recovered through the Supply Adjustment Charge.

As of January 1, 2025, the Companies will no longer recover the cost of the Out of Market portion of the Environmental Value through the Transition Charge. At that time, both the Market and the Out of Market portions of the Environmental Value will be recovered from non-retail access customers only through the Supply Adjustment Charge.

Newspaper Publication

In compliance with Ordering Clause No. 5 of the Order, the requirements of Public Service Law §66(12)(b) and 16 NYCRR §720-8.1 regarding newspaper publication of the tariff amendments required in Ordering Clause No. 4 be completed prior to the effective date of the tariff amendments, are waived.
