The attached statement, issued by Niagara Mohawk, d/b/a/ National Grid, is being transmitted for filing in accordance with the requirements of the New York State Public Service Commission under Case 18-E-0138:

Residential Electric Vehicle Charge Smart Plan Statement Statement No. 3 To PSC No. 220 Electricity Effective: July 1, 2023

The Statement specifies the EV Monthly Charges for Residential EV Charge Smart Plan customers, for both Tier 1 and Tier 2 off-peak kWh usage levels available to the customer, which are unchanged. The EV Monthly Charges are each provided in separate delivery and supply charge components. The Statement also specifies the forecasted on-peak supply rate necessary to calculate the EV On-peak Rebate. Attachment 1 provides the detailed rate components that were used to develop the EV Monthly Charges. Attachment 2 details the rates used to calculate the monthly EV On-peak and EV Off-peak Rebates for EV Charge Smart Plan customer bills.

This Residential Electric Vehicle Charge Smart Plan Statement is filed with the Commission not less than thirty (30) days before the effective date in accordance with Special Provision N of Service Classification No. 1 of PSC No. 220. Residential Electric Vehicle Charge Smart Plan Statement No. 3 is effective July 1, 2023, for batch billed customers and calendar month billed customers.
