In accordance with the Joint Proposal approved by the Public Service Commission in an Order dated August 12, 2021, in the above-captioned matter (the “Order”), The Brooklyn Union Gas Company d/b/a National Grid NY (“KEDNY”) hereby submits its Statement of Newtown Creek Revenue Reconciliation (“NCRR”) in compliance with Rule 56 of the Company’s tariff PSC No. 12 – Gas. Since the NCRR rate is one of the components included in the Statement of Delivery Rate Adjustment (“DRA”), the DRA statement will be filed once all July 1st rate statements have been submitted.
