The above statements are being filed in accordance with Rule 59 - Arrears Management Program ("AMP") Surcharge of PSC No. 220 Electricity. The AMP Phase 1 rates are unchanged on this AMP Recovery Statement No. 3 and the AMP Phase 2 rates have been updated with the actual AMP Phase 2 arrears forgiveness amounts and recovery period.

Attachment 1 displays the summary of costs of the AMP Phase 2 program including Economic Development Deferral offset values. Attachment 2 displays the unit rate calculation based on the costs to recover, allocated by service classification using the Company's current Write-Offs allocator, and then divided by the forecasted usage by service classification. Attachment 3 contains the estimated carrying charges for the recovery period using the Company's currently approved weighted average cost of capital rate.

The AMP Surcharge Statement is to be filed with the Commission on not less than five (5) days' notice before the effective date. The AMP Surcharge Statement No. 3 is effective March 1, 2023 for batch billed customers and March 1, 2023 for calendar month billed customers.
