The Company filed tariff revisions on December 2, 2022, in compliance with Ordering Clause No. 14 of the Order which directed the Company to file tariff leaves to implement participation incentives. The Company is filing revised tariff leaves herein to include further modifications after discussions with Commission Staff following the original filing date. The modifications are in Special Provision N of Service Classification No. 1 for the Company’s Residential Electric Vehicle Charge Smart Plan (“Residential EVCS Program”), and Rule 52, Electric Vehicle Make Ready (“EVMR”) Surcharge. The modifications to the Residential EVCS Program are primarily to distinguish between the Tier kWhs used to design the Monthly EV Charge and the Tier kWhs up to which the customer may receive incentives for off-peak electric vehicle charging. The modifications to the EVMR Surcharge clarify that program enrollment incentives provided to customers would also be recovered through the EVMR Surcharge, in compliance with Ordering Clauses Nos. 24 and 25. Attachment A to this filing contains the redlined tariff leaves for this amendment.

In accordance with Ordering Clause No. 37 of the Order, the requirements of PSL 66(12) (b) and 16 NYCRR §720.8.1 concerning newspaper publication of the proposed tariff amendment described in Ordering Clause No. 14 are waived.
