Dear Secretary Phillips:

In accordance with General Information Sections 36.A of P.S.C. No. 15 - Electricity, the Statement listed below is filed by Central Hudson Gas & Electric Corporation ("Central Hudson" or "the Company") to become effective January 1, 2023.

P.S.C. No. 15 – Electricity

Statement of Systems Benefit Charge SBC - 47

Pursuant to the Company's tariff, the Company routinely files a Statement of System Benefits Charge ("SBC Statement") in December to be effective with the first billing batch of the Company's January billing cycle. The purpose of this filing is to incorporate the current annual assessment amounts and a reconciliation of recoveries (eleven months actual, one month forecast) with the prior year's authorized collections. Furthermore, pursuant to Case 20-M-0082, Integrated Energy Data Resource (IEDR) costs are included in the Clean Energy Fund surcharge. The Company has included Central Hudson's allocation of the 2023 anticipated Phase I IEDR assessment per the November 2022 NYSERDA invoice for recovery over calendar year 2023. The IEDR incorporates a reconciliation of recoveries (eleven months actual, one month forecast) with 2022 estimated collections per the November 2022 NYSERDA invoice.
