In compliance with Ordering Clause No. 2 of the Public Service Commission's Order Directing Tariff Filings (the "Order") in the above referenced proceeding, issued and effective November 21, 2022, New York State Electric & Gas Corporation ("NYSEG") and Rochester Gas and Electric Corporation ("RG&E"), (together the "Companies"), hereby file the following tariff leaves to become effective on January 1, 2023.

Purpose of Filing

The Companies are filing amendments to their respective electric tariffs in compliance with Ordering Clause No. 2 of the Order to align the Companies standby rate exemptions with the other New York utilities. In accordance with the Order, the Companies are amending their respective standby tariffs to provide for an exemption from Standby Service for a customer that operates electric energy storage with a maximum inverter capability of up to and including 1 MW.
