RE: Filing to Reset Gas Factor of Adjustment and Line Loss Factor

Dear Secretary Phillips:

Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. hereby submits for filing with the Public Service Commission the 17th Revised Leaf No. 157.1 proposing revisions to its Schedule for Gas Service, P.S.C. No. 9 – Gas (the “Gas Tariff”).

This tariff leaf is issued November 30, 2022, to become effective January 1, 2023. This filing is made pursuant to General Information Section No. VII (A)1.(d) of the Gas Tariff.

The purpose of this filing is to update the Factor of Adjustment (“FOA”) and the line loss factor (“LLF”) as contained in General Information Section No. VII (A)1.(d). The FOA is used to adjust the cost of gas to reflect lost and unaccounted for gas for each twelve-month period commencing January 1 based upon the average of actual line losses for the preceding five twelve-month periods ending August. The FOA, effective January 1, 2023, will change from its current level of 1.0288 to 1.0340 and is based the updated LLF of 3.287 percent, which reflects the actual line losses for the five-year period ended August 31, 2022.
