Dear Secretary Phillips:

This filing is submitted by Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation d/b/a National Grid (“the Company”) in compliance with the Commission’s Order of March 15, 2018 in the above proceeding.

The Company is setting the ETIP reconciliation rates to zero for SC-5 and SC-8 customers commencing June 1, 2022. The Company has reconciled the actual gas ETIP revenues recovered from these customers to the amount included in rates over the term of the Company’s previous Rate Plan and any over/under balance resulting from sales variances will be included in the Company’s next ETIP reconciliation at the end of its current Rate Plan per Case 20-G-0381. Since the ETIP reconciliation rate is one of the components included in the Statement of Delivery Service Adjustment, the DSA has been updated accordingly.
