RE: Statement of Percentage Increase in Rates and Charges

Dear Secretary Phillips:

Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. (the "Company") is filing the following Statement of Percentage Increase in Rates and Charges to PSC No. 10 - Electricity, in accordance with General Rule 30:

GRT Statement No. 25 to PSC No. 10 - Electricity Effective June 2, 2022

The revisions to the Statement of Percentage Increase in Rates and Charges applicable to the Company's electric tariff, to take place in June 2022, reflect the annual reconciliation of MTA revenues and expense.

The Company's electric tariff provides that revenues collected during the MTA surcharge billing year (April 2021 through March 2022) be compared with MTA surcharge expense for the calendar year 2020. The Company under-collected \$374,309.34 for its electric operations. The New York City reconciliation adjustment will be 0.1262% and 0.0251% for residential and non-residential delivery, respectively. The effect of the factors in the various Westchester municipalities varies due to the impact of local levies on the computation of the effective tax factors used in the electric statement.
