Purpose of Filing

The Companies are submitting tariff revisions to modify the Value Stack compensation methodologies.

Pursuant to Ordering Clause No. 4 of the Order, the Companies are directed to file tariff amendments to modify the compensation methodology for the Environmental component of the Value Stack. The Environmental Component will be set forth on the Value Stack Credit Statement in P.S.C. 19 and P.S.C. 120. The value for the Environmental component will be fixed for the term of a project that qualifies for Value Stack compensation.
